4-H Offers Geocaching Training for Adult Leaders

A geocaching/GPS skills training program will be offered by Cornell Cooperative Extension Schoharie County on Saturday, May 30 from 10:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. at Cobleskill Library. The 4-H workshop is geared toward 4-H, scout, and other youth group leaders who will be working with children this summer. Geocaching is a high tech treasure hunt that uses a Global Positioning System to hide and locate caches. The workshop will be a hands-on training of the technology behind the sport, the fundamentals of finding caches, and using the technology with youth. During the training, participants will search for caches in downtown Cobleskill. Handheld GPS units will be available for use during the workshop and are available for loan to youth organizations.
