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Hands-On Food Preservation Workshops

Cornell Cooperative Extension Schoharie County will present workshops on a variety of food preservation techniques. All workshops will be held at the Extension Center, 173 South Grand Street across from the Sunshine Fairgrounds. Space is limited to 15 participants per workshop. Registration and \$15.00 per workshop is required.

The program schedule is as follows; starting times do vary: Boiling Water Canning, Thursday, June 10, 5:30 – 9:00 p.m. Step-by-step process for preserving high-acid foods like tomatoes, fruits, and pickles; Freezing, Wednesday, June 16, 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. Freezing summer's bounty; meats, jams, vegetables and more will be discussed; Pressure Canning, Tuesday, July 8, 5:30 – 9:00 p.m. Step-by-step process for preserving low acid foods like vegetables and meats.
