On Saturday, May 7, a free Lunch & Learn Seminar on Energy Saving Resources will be presented by Mark De Chiro, Energy \$mart Coordinator from the Capital District, at The Extension Center, 173 South Grand Street, Cobleskill. The program is offered from 11:30 a.m. until 1:30 p.m.
