GROWING DINNER IN YOUR BACKYARD WORKSHOPS

Master Gardener volunteers with Cornell Cooperative Extension Schoharie County are conducting a backyard vegetable gardening workshop series in March. All are welcome to attend the two remaining workshops on Tuesday, March 18 and March 25 from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. at the Extension Center, 173 South Grand Street, Cobleskill. There is a \$10 charge for each workshop. Pre-registration is encouraged but not required.

The seed planting time-table will be reviewed on March 18 in a workshop titled Starting Seeds and Transplanting. Master Gardeners will elaborate on when to transplant seedlings, and will have participants work on starting vegetable and herb seeds.

Growing Organically, on March 25, will explore simple steps that can be taken to grow vegetables organically. The Master Gardeners will talk about compost piles, organic mulches, natural pest management, and other organic gardening issues.
